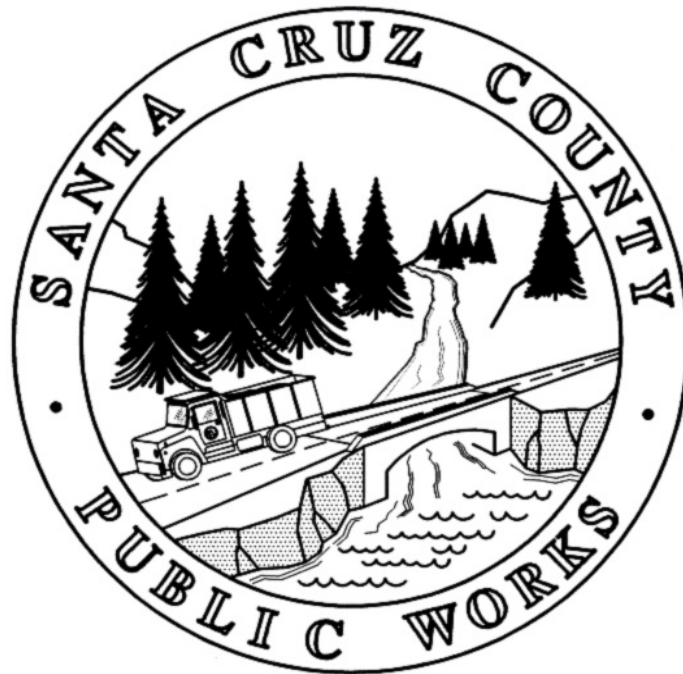

**OFFSITE TRANSPORTATION AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENT FEE CREDITS  
FOR APTOS, LIVE OAK, PAJARO VALLEY AND SOQUEL**

This schedule allows a credit against the transportation and roadside improvement fees, up to the full amount of fees, whenever a developer is required to construct offsite transportation or roadside improvements which are included in the inventory of capital improvements.

Valuation of transportation and roadside improvements shall be established by the approving body at the time of discretionary permit approval based upon this schedule.

Preliminary engineered improvement plans are required for determining the type and quantity of roadside and roadway improvements eligible for construction cost credit.

Credits detailed below are at maximum allowed and are dependent on developer's documentation of cost.

**WORK WITHOUT A PERMIT**

Whenever any work, for which an encroachment permit is required by the Encroachment Ordinance, has commenced without first obtaining said permit, a special investigation shall be made before a permit may be issued for such work. An investigation fee, in addition to the permit fee, shall be collected whether or not a permit is then, or subsequently, issued. The investigation fee shall be equal to the amount of the permit fee required by the Unified Fee Schedule. The payment of such investigation fee shall not exempt any person from compliance with all other provisions of the Encroachment Ordinance nor from any penalty prescribed by law.
